Workshop Description

In concert with the increasing acknowledgement of deaf ministries within the hearing church and vice versa, there are many expectations as it relates to equal access. This workshop defines equal access, explains the differences between certified and qualified, deals with oppression for deaf consumers by interpreters and the hearing church culture, and addresses deaf patrons who are willing to accept sub-standard services out of a sense of obligation. The workshop will compare the Americans with Disabilities Act with biblical perspective on this issue.

Workshop Objectives

This presentation will identify and explore key concepts of the Americans with Disabilities Act and their application to performing services in the church and other venues. Discussion on the roles and responsibilities of the interpreters and the clients they serve will take place. The workshop will also address attitude, boundaries, ethics, expectations, oppression and both the importance and implication of setting.
