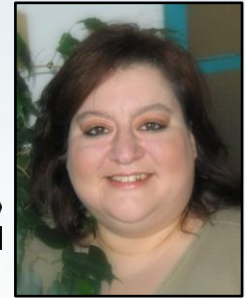

Anne Orozco, CI & CT, NIC, is an interpreter dedicated to the ideals of the profession of interpreting, having contributed both in the field as a working professional and for RID as a volunteer on National Committees. She has been working as a professional interpreter since 1993. Ms. Orozco is certified with the RID and sat on the Board of the Illinois State Affiliate Chapter. She is currently providing interpreting services for a Deaf attorney and consumers at the non-profit legal advocacy agency, Equip for Equality, in Chicago, Illinois. Ms. Orozco also works as a freelance interpreter in a multitude of settings. She has also long been involved with RID on the Regional and National level and was a case reviewer for the RID National Ethical Practices Committee, a member of the National Ethical Practices Oversight Committee writing policy for the Ethical Practices System while being the chairperson to the RID Professional Standards Committee.

This workshop will give a detailed explanation of interpreting an average AA meeting and interpreting in an addiction recovery setting. Specifically, a quick overview of the 12 steps and 12 traditions will be discussed. This workshop is ideal for those interested in working in the recovery setting or for those interested in obtaining more information about it. Some background knowledge about this topic would be helpful but is not required. Discussion and demonstration of some vocabulary may be demonstrated as well as a discussion of ethical issues that arise in this setting.
